6 DAILY CONFESSIONS

I speak a certain number of Scriptures every day with my morning coffee. These Scriptures have changed my life and resulted in miracles. Why? Because the Word is so powerful in our mouths. Here are some Scriptures I have spoken through the years that I believe can apply to anyone, no matter what situation they are in.

1. Jesus is the Lord over my day. *"If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God" (Colossians 3:1).*

He's Lord over your day and your disposition! You may wake up in a bad mood. You may find that everyone around you is negative. That's when you need to remember that Jesus is still Lord. He's still on the throne, and He wants to bring life into your day.

2. I'm a new creation in Christ. *"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new" (2 Corinthians 5:17).*

You're born again with a new spirit, a new nature, and a new thought life. You were created to be the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. He is completing you in His image day by day.

3. I cast my cares on the Lord. *"Cast your burden on the Lord, and He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved" (Psalm 55:22). "...Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7).*

Start your day by giving every worry and care to the Lord. His yoke is easy, and His burden is light

(see Matthew 11:30). Once you give the Lord your cares, don't forget to leave them there.

4. I shall not want. *"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want" (Psalm 23:1).*

The Lord is your good shepherd, and you shall not want for any good thing, whether it be spiritual, physical, or material. God is your Jehovah Jireh; He has already seen ahead to meet your needs.

5. He bore my sicknesses, my griefs, and my sorrows. *"He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses" (Matthew 8:17).*

Jesus took all of these on Himself at the cross. You can't change your own sickness and sorrow. Only the Lord can change them.

6. I have the mind of Christ. *"For 'who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?' But we have the mind of Christ" (1 Corinthians 2:16).*

When you determine to speak God's Word in faith, the Holy Spirit will quicken Scriptures to your remembrance. Each day, confess that you have the mind of the Lord. Then expect Him to work with your thoughts.
